विषय / Sub: Export of Black Tiger Shrimp to Japan – regarding.

Consequent to detection of muddy-moldy smell in Black Tiger Shrimp exported to Japan from India, the MPEDA in consultation with the SEAI has been taking steps to improve the quality of Shrimp exported to Japan through various measures like education of farmers, Good Aquaculture Practices (GAP). Training of technicians in detection of Muddy-Moldy smell and traceability with a view to retrieving exports to the Japanese Market. Subsequently the exporters were given notice of certain requirements to be met with regard to the Black Tiger Shrimp exports to Japan vide letter No. JD (QC) /TA/2004/HO dated 17.01.2005 of the Authority and the said letter was circulated among all the exporters of the AP region by the SEAI (A.P. Region) and no objection was received from the exporters.

In pursuance of the decision of the Authority at it's meeting, held on 16.02.2005, the following instructions had been issued for compliance by every exporter exporting cultured Black Tiger Shrimp Sourced from the Ponds of Andhra Pradesh with effect from 10/4/2005.

- (i) The processing plants /Exporter should put in place a satisfactory traceability system to meet adequately requirement of Japanese importers.
- (ii) Attach to the shipping bills

In light of the instruction number (ii) above, all exporters are now required to attach an undertaking (signed by the exporter himself) to the effect that the Black Tiger shrimp were not caught from low-salinity water /fresh water in respect of exports made from 10.4.2005. You are therefore requested to kindly ensure that the above documents is attached with every shipping bill meant for the export of Black Tiger Shrimp to Japan in case of no such undertaking attached, you may kindly reject the shipping bill.
