Attention of all Importers, Exporters, CHAs and the Trading Public is invited to the procedures to be followed in this Custom House as per the letter and circular of Spices Board, Cochin 682 025 which is reproduced below.

Letter No. MD/CHI/01/03 dated 26th May 2005 of Spices Board, Cochin.

Sub: Condition for export of Chilli/Chilli products – analytical report for the presence of Sudan I-IV Aflatoxin.

Enclosed please find a copy of our circular of even number dated 26th May, 2005 issued under the provisions of the Spices Board (Registration of Exporters) Amendment Regulations, 2004, in continuation of our earlier circulars of even number dated 07.03.2005 and 28.03.2005 stipulating that submission of analytical report issued by the Spices Board to the effect that the consignment does not contain Aflatoxin beyond acceptable limits is compulsory to clear export consignments of chilli products / food products containing chilli products in whatsoever form to Canada and Japan also in addition to EU, USA, Middle East countries, Australia and New Zealand.

As already communicated to you, in case of export consignments of Chilli/chilli products to be shipped to other destinations (other than those listed above), exporters need produce, at the time of clearance, only certificate issued by the Spices Board / authorized agency that a sample from the consignment has been drawn. The date from which the submission of analytical report will be made compulsory in respect of consignments to other destinations will be notified later.

With respect to chilli powder/chilli products and food products containing chilli, analytical report from the Spices Board to the effect that the product is **free of Sudan** is compulsory for all destinations with effect from 10.03.2005 as per Circular of even number dated 07.03.2005.
